Scholarship Tip #4: Don't be vague about your future

A good rule of thumb when writing a scholarship essay is to be specific rather than vague. When writing an essay it is easy to use common labels such as doctor, actor, or artist to describe your future. But describing yourself with that label does not tell the scholarship committee what is *different* about you; why do you stand out from the

millions of other students that label themselves as "artists". For example if you write about being an artist, that is good. But if you write about being an artist who wants to teach inner-city children how to express their emotions through painting, then you sound amazing. If you include details on what you want to do and why you

want to do it, you will stand out. Also, it is a good idea to talk about your future plans and how you will be helping others. You do not want to come across money hungry so describe why you want to go into your profession. All of you artists have huge passion and dedication to your art, so write about it!

Not to mention that advertisers are redundant and poorly represent the outside scholarships available. Not to worry! www.thewashboard.org is a great scholarship resource for Washington

State residents. The recently launched site gives both scholarship providers and scholarship searchers an avenue to meet. In addition students can load in their resume and other supporting documents so that scholarship providers can actively seek out applicants. Also with a click of the mouse students can apply directly for schol-

arships straight from the website. This is seriously a wonderful tool. Even though this is a new site and they are still working out the kinks, I would still say this is the best scholarship search site I have seen.



Alfred G. and Elma M. Milotte Scholarship

The Alfred G. and Elma m. Milotte Scholarship is awarded to students who show a passion and appreciation for nature. The scholarship recipients will be individuals who share their enthusiasm for exploring, chronicling and spreading the magnificence of the wilderness

through artistic communication. The Milotte's studied exotic animals and mainly chronicled their observations via film. To qualify you must appreciate nature through artistic expression including song, poetry, writing, or visual art. Applicants must be Washington State resi-

dents for at least five years and have a 3.0 GPA or higher. This \$4000 scholarship is perfect for any student who can show their appreciation for nature through artistic expression.

Frame my Future Scholarship Contest

This is a fun and easy scholarship!! All applicants must do is submit an 8X11 piece of artwork showing

how they "frame their future". Applicants can use any means of artistic expression to communicate how they view their future. Some ideas for submission are paintings, photography, collage, poem, graphic design, or ANYTHING you create! The submissions are

online and must be in jpg format. The top 24 entries will be chosen by Church Hill Classics and put to an open online vote. The top five entries will receive \$1000 and the top entry will receive an additional \$1000 for their schools scholarship endowment fund. Due:03/31/2010



Tax Time!

Taxes can be daunting especially if you have never had to complete them before. But luckily they are not as worrisome as we are led to believe especially when you utilize the wonderful resources that are available. The most important thing is to FILE! You will most likely get a refund! I am a personal fan of Turbo Tax. Although Turbo Tax will try to convince you to pay for an upgrade, if you stick to your guns filing will be free. In addition to filing on your own, there are organizations that provide free tax assistance.

Theater of Puget Sound will offer the Kevin Hadley VITA workshop to help artists file their taxes. Also, United Way of King County offers tax assistance to low income filers earning under \$50,000. There are over 17 locations in King County offering tax assistance with the United Nations. In addition as a student you may qualify for one of three education tax deductions that will put money in your pocket! Now, you are going to want to talk to your parents. Depending

on how much money you made last year your parents might benefit more from the education tax credits. If your parents provide more than 50% of your support they are entitled to claim you as a dependent. However, you will want to sit down with them and discuss your options. Either way, doing your taxes can mean great things for students. Most likely you can end up with some extra cash, YAY!
