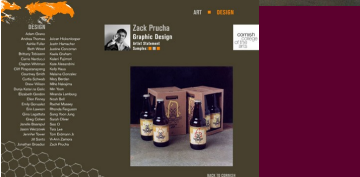


Scholarship Tip # 15: Apply for LOTS of Scholarships

Often students are discouraged because they feel there are no scholarships out there for which they qualify. My recommendation is that you apply for scholarship that you may not necessarily feel you fit 100%. For example, there are a few essay contests for students who are passionate about the environment. These scholarships are offered through small organizations that don't get many applications. Therefore, if

you can make a strong enough case that you love nature; you may have a good chance at being awarded that scholarship. You might be surprised at how few applications some scholarship organizations get and how far a well put together essay can get you. Also, quite a few organizations that offer scholarships to Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgendered and Queer (LGBTQ) students also open up their scholarships

to "Allied Supporters". If you support gay rights and have a commitment to the LGBTQ community, you would also qualify for these scholarships. It can't hurt to apply, ever. Yes, you may take time out of your schedule but the more scholarships applications you complete, the better your chances of getting at least one. You may be surprised how persuasive you can be!



FAFSA (Last time, I promise)

The Priority Deadline for filing the FAFSA is February 15th. If you are reading this on the 16th and have missed this deadline, fear not, you can still submit your FAFSA. No matter when you file the FAFSA during your year of attendance, federal aid such as

the Pell Grant and Stafford Loans are available. It is true that we cannot guarantee the best financial aid package possible if you don't meet the priority deadline. This however does not mean that you will receive nothing if you miss it. Some funds are

awarded on a first-come first-serve basis, so as long as we have funds remaining we will award them. As the saying goes, better late than never!
