Back to School Budget



It's time to start pinching pennies again! Back to school means back to a budget and the Financial Aid Office wants to help. Here are some tips to keep your account in the black. First and foremost, don't eat out! Buy meals at the grocery store, you can buy a whole week's worth of sandwiches for less than one subway sandwich. A grocery list will save you from impulse spending. Don't let your food go to waste. Invest in some chip clips to prevent food

from going stale. Track your spending to find out where your money is going. Often you will realize that Starbucks is sucking your savings or that Whole Foods is costing you a Whole Lot! After you have tracked your monthly spending you need to set a budget for yourself. First, start by making a plan. Write down a list of all the money you have coming in such as your aid refund, work income or money from your parents. Then make another list of all the bills and ex-

penses coming out of your budget such as rent, food, transportation and utilities. Next subtract the bills each month from the amount of money you have coming in. The remainder is your spending money for the month. Do not touch the money you know needs to go towards bills or other expenses. Pay your bills on time and don't overdraft your account, fees are expensive! For more budgeting tips and tools, keep an eye out for budgeting sessions put on by Cornish staff.

In reality, the financial aid process needs to be thought through during the year before the start of the next term (that would be NOW). We absolutely want to emphasize the necessity

of planning ahead. Outside scholarships come due generally between October and May. Although you may have some summer-straggler-scholarships, you need to apply for the heavy hitters NOW. By applying for scholarships early you will not only beat the rush of applicants but you will be well prepared come tuition time next year. I cannot tell you how many calls I got this summer asking about outside scholarships and unfor-

tunately summer is too late. I encourage every student to take charge of their education, now rather than later. If there has been anything we can learn from this difficult year, it is that unfortunate things happen when we least expect it. If students plan ahead and apply for outside scholarships they may avoid difficulties come tuition payment time.
