

NEW STUDENT INFORMATION PACKET

Welcome

Congratulations and welcome to Cornish College of the Arts, we're excited to have you joining our community. Living on campus offers students a unique living-learning experience that nurtures creativity and intellectual curiosity. All new students are required to live on campus and purchase a meal plan for their first academic year.

Certain students are eligible to apply for a housing and meal plan exemption. For example, students who are 21 years of age or older, students who have completed 30 credits of postsecondary coursework elsewhere, or students who have children living in the home may contact Housing and Residence Life for the appropriate paperwork. For a full list of exemptions please visit www.cornish.edu/housing.

New students will want to complete and submit their housing and meal plan contract as soon as possible, no later than summer registration or July 31, whichever comes first. For students admitted after July 31, housing contracts are due 2 weeks after date of admission. The \$300 housing deposit check should be submitted with housing paperwork and paid to the order of "Cornish College of the Arts" with "housing deposit" and the student's last name or ID number in the memo space.

Room and roommate assignments for the 2010 – 2011 academic year will be made in early August and residents will be notified of assignments by August 15, 2010 via Cornish email. This summer the Housing and Residence Life website (www.cornish.edu/housing) will undergo a significant revision and will be a great place to find information.
