Policies to Know

CREDIT LOAD: 12 credits or more is full time. To take more than 18 credits, you must be approved by the registrar. You must pay per credit over 18.

ADD/DROP: You can add or drop classes through the 8th day of the semester. After that day, you may drop a class and your transcript will show a W (withdrawal) through the 11th week of the semester. GRADE FORGIVENESS: If you receive a C- or below, you may apply to repeat the course one time using this policy. Both attempts will appear on your transcript, but only the second attempt will factor into your GPA.

TRANSFER CREDITS: All transfer credits from work prior to Cornish should be received by the end of your first semester at Cornish. To complete courses at outside institutions and transfer credits back after you have started at Cornish, you must complete a Transfer After Matriculation Form. Without this the credits will not transfer.

RESIDENCY: You must complete at least 60 credits at Cornish. Your final two semesters must be taken only at Cornish. You cannot transfer in any credits, or CBE/PLE during your last two semesters.
